Remember we are going to vote on the changes listed below, today.

Article II – Section 1 Church Officers & Constitution # 4

The church shall elect deacons by ballot on the fourth Sunday in October. A ballot shall be presented to the members present on the third Sunday in October, and each member is allowed to nominate three persons for the office of deacon. The ballots are then counted and the six persons with the largest number of votes who are willing to serve shall be presented to the church on conference Sunday as nominees. The three receiving the largest number of ballots shall serve on the fellowship of deacons taking office on January 1. The fellowship of deacons shall be composed of nine elected members until the church deems it necessary to change this number, and this would require an amendment to the constitution.

Article VI. - Section 3 Regular Business Meetings

The church shall have monthly business meetings. The meetings will be scheduled on the 3rd Wednesday night or the fifth Sunday morning of each month. The day and time of these meetings shall be placed on the church calendar.
